Sandan	£25	£45

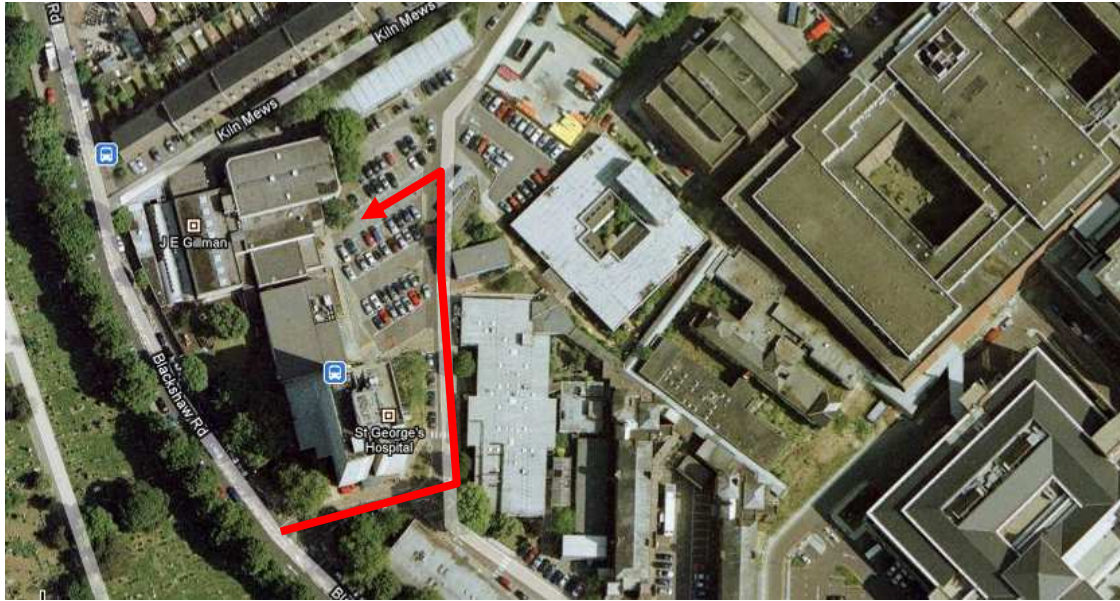
The closing date for grading applications is Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> March.

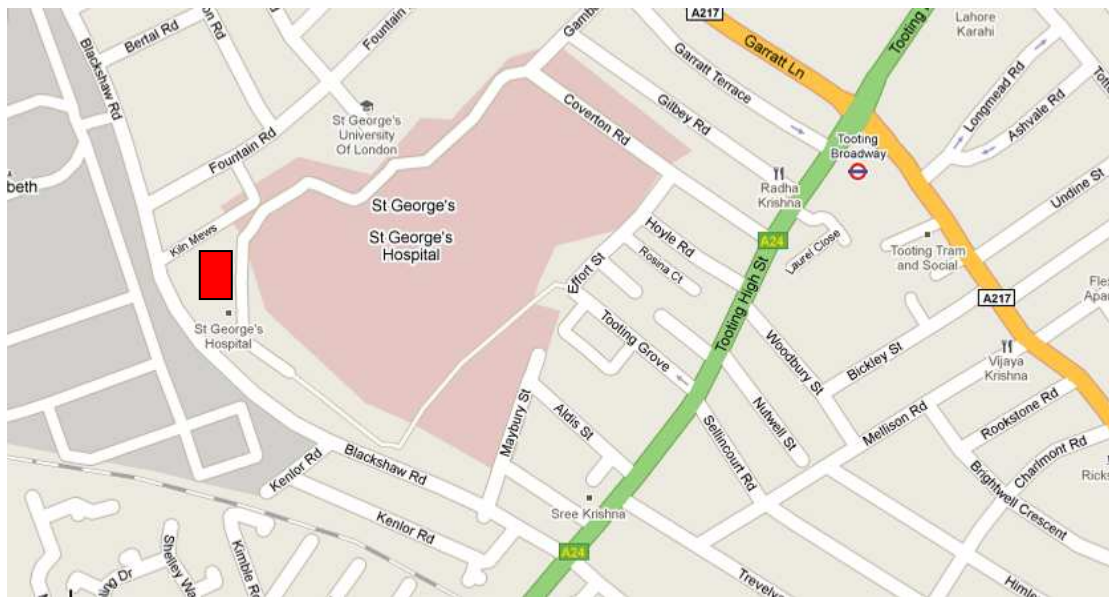
